Industry performance in November 2023

Industrial production in October 2023 increased by 1.6 per cent year-on-year and rose by 4.1 per cent compared to the previous month as the Central Statistical Office reported.

After eliminating the impact of seasonal factors, industrial production sold in October this year was 0.8 per cent lower than in the same month last year and 0.1 per cent lower than in September this year.

GOVERNMENT SUPPORT The zero VAT rate on food, which was previously subject to a 5% tax rate, has been in place since February last year. This rule will be maintained until the end of 2023, we have no information if it is continued next year, everything depends on the new authorities. The government has adopted a draft law to protect electricity, gas fuel and heat consumers; it envisages an extension of the protection mechanisms in place until 2023.
